## Comfortably away from it all

The spirit of adventure is in all of us – indeed with the stress of modern living, much more so. But escape from the daily routine must include sophisticated comforts to which modern living standards have accustomed us. Motor-caravanning goes a long way to achieving

this – provided the basic requirements of engineering skill, versatility and practical know-how are satisfied. These are criteria which the Trailblazer takes in its stride, for it combines the skills of one of the world's leading caravan manufacturers and most experienced commercial

vehicle makers. Based on the renowned Bedford CF 220 van, and superbly fashioned by CI Autohomes' experienced craftsmen, the Trailblazer is at once a sophisticated leisure vehicle and a stylish, everyday mode of transport. It exudes quality – from its smart contours, glistening enhanced by touches of chrome, superb insulation in roof and body sides to meet a wide range of climates, excellent space utilisation, high-quality fitments – in all, a subtle blend of practicality and class.

A feeling of spaciousness is essential for a vehicle of this type. Step inside and see for yourself. Designed to accommodate four adults, the interior gives ample room for them to sit, eat, sleep or travel. The rear two forward-facing seats can quickly and easily be

converted into a transverse double bed – 1 829 × 1 181mm (6' 0" × 3' 10½") or, with the detachable table, they form a cosy dinette with inward-facing seats on each side.

Now look up at the Trailblazer elevating roof. Two gas-filled struts on either side make raising or lowering it a simple pleasure; the completely vertical side-panels give ample space and a tall headroom, over virtually the entire living area, of 1 905mm (6' 3"); there is a useful storage shelf *over the cab*, when the roof is raised, and space for two Rollaway bunks of 1 829 × 635mm\* (6' 0" × 2' 1"\*)). When raised, the roof is rigid and fully-insulated against noise, from wind or rain, and changing temperatures. When lowered, it locks down automatically.

Another essential is good light and visibility. You have it in Trailblazer.

All-round vision below, with a sliding window where it is needed (over the kitchen unit); eye-level windows above - plus the transparent rooflight.

Storage-space is important too. Again you have it. Forward shelf in the elevated roof; cupboards under the seats, in the rear doors, above and to the side of the recess for the optional gas/12-volt refrigerator; plus a generous wardrobe.

Privacy? Just swish round the gaily coloured curtains (including those in the cab), switch on the two fluorescent lights (transistorised to save your battery) and there you are - away from it all.

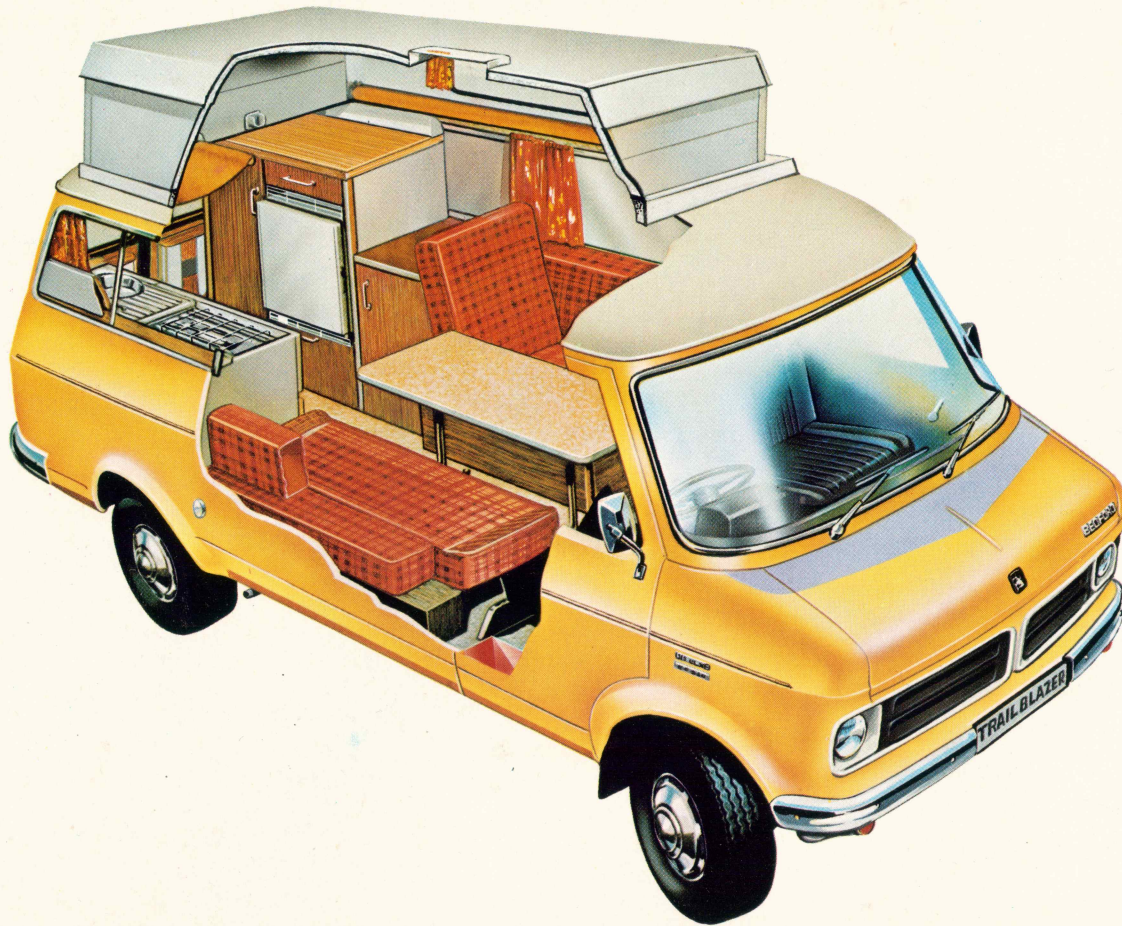
Kitchen equipment includes a combination stainless steel sink and two-burner hotplate with grill, fresh-water feed to the sink via a foot-operated electric pump from a 72 litre (16 gallon) storage tank, and

gas bottle storage in a floor-level ventilated compartment. And the entire rear floor is covered in hard-wearing, easy-to-clean, practical vinyl.

On the move, Trailblazer handles just like a car. Commanding driving position, precise rack and pinion steering, light gearchange, easily-accessible controls and independent front suspension ensure the smoothest of rides. The cab itself is superbly styled with body-contoured seats, armrests, padded dash, headlining, floor carpeting and extensive sound insulation - plus walk-through access to the rear.

But the Trailblazer's value and quality go even further. Even with its extensive luxury specification, it costs little more than a medium-size car, yet offers more leisure freedom than you ever imagined possible.





### Chassis specification

Bedford CF 220 van with de luxe cab, passenger cab seat, raised suspension, cab interior mirror, spare wheel and tyre, servo assisted brakes. CF 250 van optional at extra cost.

### Body specification

Combination stainless steel sink and two burner hotplate with grill. Fresh water feed to the sink via a foot operated electric pump from a 72 litre/16 gallon storage tank. Cupboards, wardrobe, drawers, underseat lockers and rear door containers provide ample storage space, with additional storage over cab with roof elevated. Gas bottle storage is provided in a floor level ventilated compartment. Trailblazer elevating roof and folding side panels of sandwich construction giving full insulation, and gas filled struts to ensure ease of operation. Roof automatically locks down when lowered. Eye level windows in roof side panels. Main windows have polished alloy frames, window over sink/hotplate with sliding section. Air vents built into body sides. Rear seats convert to two forward-

facing, four seater dinette or double bed. Two Rollaway upper bunks in elevated roof area. Floor covered in hard wearing vinyl, curtains in gaily coloured material with matching ties. Free standing folding table. Insulated body sides. Dual gas/electric refrigerator optional extra.

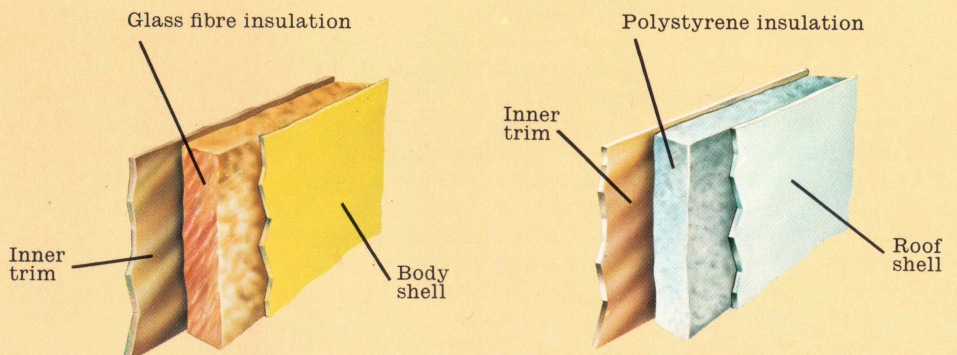
