On the test circuit, the Kitten returned 70 mpg at a constant 40 miles per hour. And 60 mpg at a constant 50 miles per hour.

The Kitten's body is designed for economy too.

The body is of hand-built glassfibre mounted onto a strong, steel chassis – something you don't find on many cars these days. And because its remarkably tough body is made of glassfibre it can't ever rust. Rain, sleet or snow won't wash away your Kitten's good looks or its resale value.

The Kitten is hand-sprayed with eight coats of paint to ensure an excellent finish for an outstanding economy car.











You'll enjoy its handling as much as its economy.

The Kitten's lively 850cc engine will give you a top speed of around 80 miles per hour and the car will cruise happily at 60 miles per hour.

Its steering is light and positive and you'll enjoy the small, sporty steering wheel.
Radial tyres enhance the already excellent road holding and handling.
It's probably the easiest car of any type to park, with a turning circle less than that of a London taxi.

And the Kitten's suspension has been so designed to ensure a smooth ride and maximum comfort on almost every kind of road surface.

If the Kitten looks good on the outside wait till you get inside.


You can choose from black or tan upholstery with matching deep pile door-to-door carpeting.

So now you can have a luxury car you can well afford to run.










